#### Exeter Job Corps Academy

Exeter's state-of-the-art, renovated facility opened in 2004, and is located only 20 minutes from downtown Providence, R.I. Local business community leaders enjoy a positive working relationship with Exeter Job Corps Academy staff, its 200 students and, most importantly, Exeter's graduates.

#### Dorm Life

Exeter Job Corps Academy has one dorm, which houses all students. Four students share a room with a full bathroom. Students have access to computers located in each dorm wing and televisions in the lounge areas.

#### On the Clock

Exeter Job Corps Academy students start the day at 6 a.m., with academic and career skills training running from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Students finish homework and enjoy free time before lights-out at 11 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. On the weekends, students can sleep in and are in the dorms by midnight, with lights-out at 1 a.m.

During the career skills training day, Exeter students wear khaki pants, polo-style or Oxford shirts and training-specific attire. During free time, students wear casual clothing in accordance with the academy dress code.

#### Family and Friends

Eligible students may request day or weekend passes. Students' families are encouraged to visit, with prior notice given.

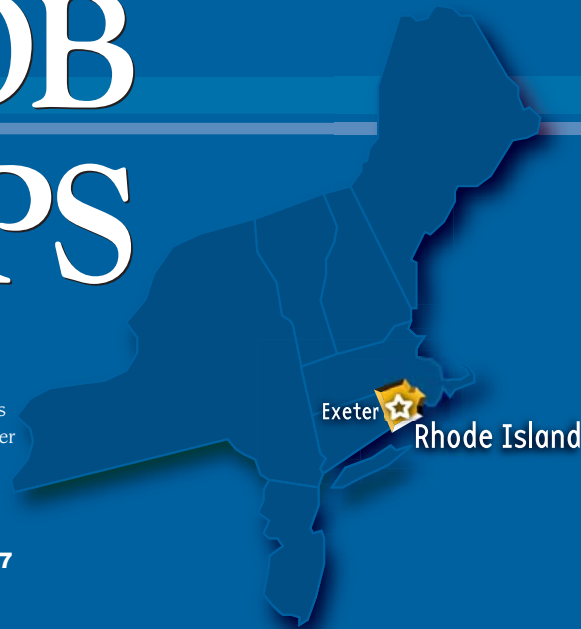

## What Is Job Corps?

Job Corps is America's leading career skills training and education program for youth ages 16 through 24. Administered by the U.S. Department of Labor, Job Corps trains 65,000 students each year.

- **Residential:** Most students live at one of 122 Job Corps campuses across the country.
- **Personal:** Staff work with students to create a personal career development plan.
- **Self-paced:** Students learn at their own pace, typically enrolled for eight months to two years.
- **No cost** to eligible students.

## Career Skills Training

Job Corps offers hands-on training in more than 60 career areas, such as auto mechanics, construction, health care and information technology – all high-growth industries. Learn computer, interview, job search and other employability skills, including how to write a resume. Job Corps teams up with employers to give students on-the-job work experience.

## Education

If you haven't finished high school, Job Corps can help you earn your diploma or GED. Job Corps

offers opportunities for higher education through partnerships with community and technical colleges.

## Life on Center

Join in fun activities such as student government, sports teams, clubs and community service projects. Job Corps centers are committed to safety and have a Zero Tolerance Policy toward drugs and violence.

Need to earn a high school diploma or GED? Exeter Job Corps Academy can help. Exeter offers classroom and online programs. Exeter also provides English as a Second Language (ESL) classes.

Want more? After graduating from Job Corps, enroll in the University of Rhode Island, the Community College of Rhode Island, the New England Institute of Technology or other Rhode Island higher-education partners.

## Your Career Training

Train in one of six career areas at Exeter Job Corps Academy, with opportunities for students to earn industry certifications:

- **Business Technology** – Study computer hardware and software, the Internet, business procedures and office operations.
- **Construction Technology** – Develop skills in light and utility equipment operation for residential building and worker management.
- **Culinary Arts** – Start training for a gourmet career under the guidance of professionally trained chefs.
- **Health Occupations Technology** – Train to be a certified nurse's assistant, group home assistant or medical records clerk.
- **Information Technology** – Investigate computer trends while building a knowledge base in computer components and operating systems and application software packages.
- **Manufacturing Technology** – Design and manufacture mechanical components using the latest technologies, such as Computer Aided Design (CAD), CNC Machines and Lean Manufacturing Strategies.
