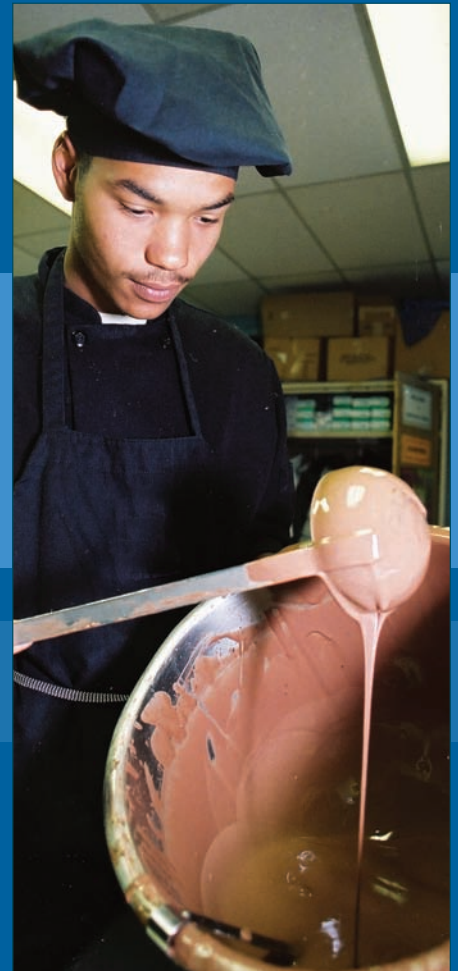
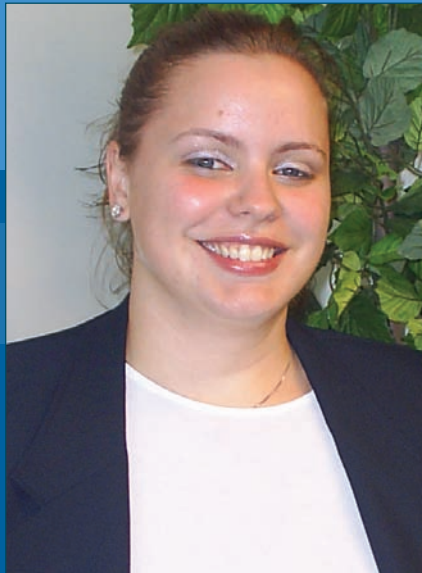
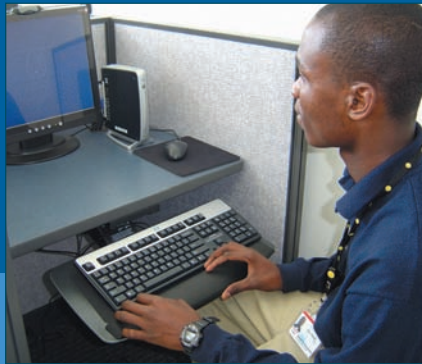
## EXETER JOB CORPS ACADEMY

At Exeter Job Corps Academy, you will receive hands-on career training from expert instructors at no cost to you. Exeter will also give you the opportunity to earn your high school diploma or GED.

When you enter the program, we work with you to create a personal career plan specific to your goals.

When you graduate, our counselors help you begin your career and find housing, transportation and other transitional needs.



### life on center

Exeter Job Corps Academy has one dorm, which houses all students. Four students share a room with a full bathroom. Exeter's state-of-the-art facility, which opened in 2004, is located only 20 minutes from downtown Providence.

The academy provides well-equipped classrooms and self-paced career skills training and academic programs in a safe environment, where a Zero Tolerance Policy for drugs and violence is strictly enforced.

## daily schedule

The training day begins each day at 8 a.m., and students attend academic classes and career skills training until 3:30 p.m. When the training day ends, and on many weekends, students can participate in center-sponsored recreational activities such as athletics, dances and outings to libraries, restaurants, movie theaters, concerts, museums and other area cultural sites.

## education

Exeter students can earn a Rhode Island state-certified high school diploma or GED, as well as college credit through partnerships with the University of Rhode Island, the Community College of Rhode Island, New England Institute of Technology or other Rhode Island higher education partnerships. Exeter also provides English as a Second Language (ESL) classes.

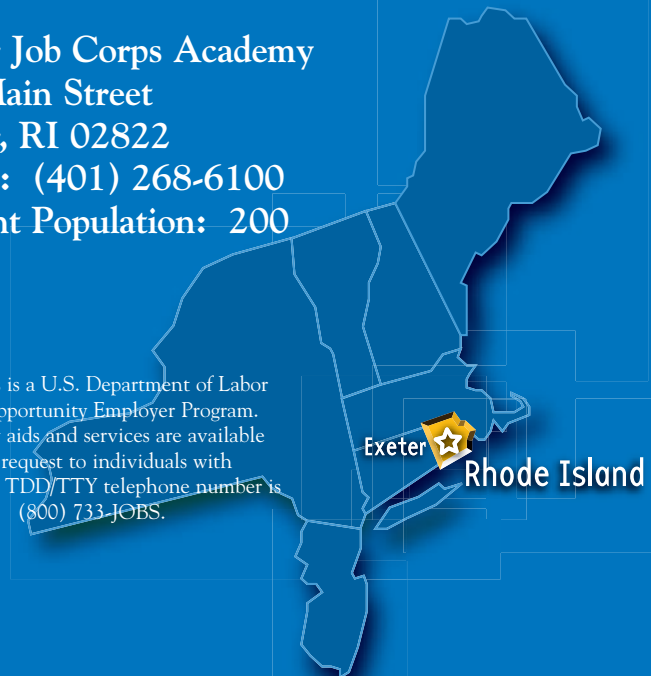
