Daily schedule

Students begin each weekday at 8 a.m. and attend academic classes and career skills training until 3:30 p.m. When the training day ends, and on many weekends, students can participate in center-sponsored recreational activities such as basketball, softball, dances and outings to libraries, restaurants, movie theaters, concerts, museums and other area cultural sites.

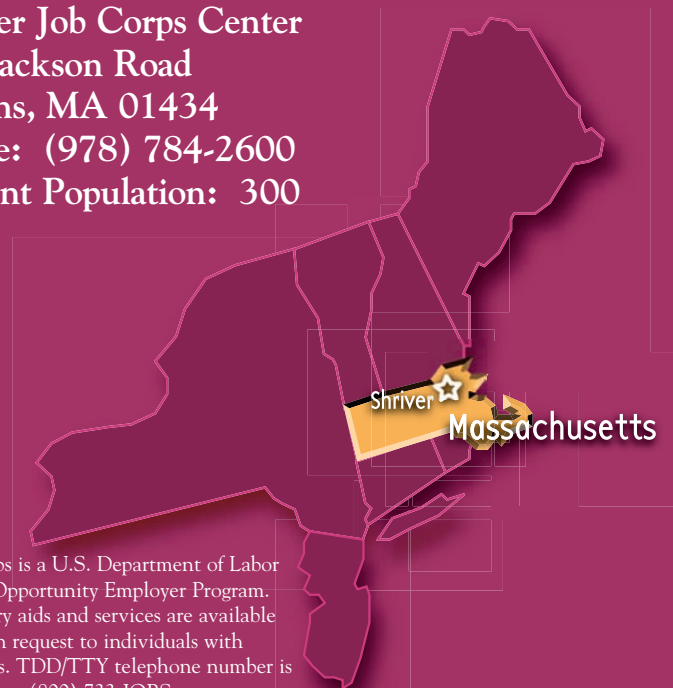
